The City of Toledo registers and licenses contractors engaged in the business of making improvements to residential structures regulated by the Residential Code of Ohio. There are two categories of contractor licenses, renewed annually:

- 1. <u>Certified Remodeling Contractor</u>. May engage in all residential construction, alterations and renovations.
- 2. <u>Limited Remodeling Contractor</u>. Restricted to residential improvements, such as window replacement, installation of insulation, fencing and swimming pools greater than 24" in depth.

To secure licensing, both categories of remodeling contractors are tested by the City's Board of Control for Home Improvement and Remodeling Contractors, with the assistance of the staff of the Division of Building Inspection. Certified Remodeling Contractors are required to pass the International Code Council's Building Contractor's examination.

To apply to take the Home Improvement and Remodeling Contractor's Exam, complete and submit the attached application with the requested documents:

- 1) Copy of the ICC completion certificate for Building Contractor C test (for Certified Remodeling Contractors ONLY).
- 2) \$200 fee. \$175 will be refunded if the Board of Control determines that you are not qualified to take its test.
- 3) Forms documenting that you meet the requirements established by the Board of Control.

Applications are reviewed by the Home Improvement and Remodeling Contractors Board of Control. Once approved, an applicant is notified in writing to appear for the next scheduled examination. Failure to appear for a test will cause the application to be closed. No refund will be granted. Specially administered exams may be scheduled for an additional fee.

The City's Home Improvement and Remodeling Contractor's exam covers material in the Toledo Municipal Code, Part 13 Building Code and Part 11 Zoning Code. The exam is open book.

The codes are available on the City of Toledo's Website www.toledo.oh.gov. Click on City Council. Click on City of Toledo Charter. The amlegal.com/library website comes up. Search for the sections of the code listed below. These codes are also available for purchase at One Government Center, Suite 1600. Codes may be mailed, upon request, for the following fees:

Part 13 \$10.60 (+\$2.21 postage) Part 11 - \$17.00 (+\$3.95 postage) Total for mailing both - \$33.76

This exam is open book allowing you to utilize your reference material noted above.

When the exam is passed, the applicant is required to submit a Certificate of Tax Registration from the City of Toledo Division of Taxation before a license can be issued and will be renewable annually.

BUILDING CONTRACTOR C – ICC EXAMINATION

Completing the ICC exam is a pre-requisite for those applying to become Certified Remodeling Contractors to sit for the City of Toledo Exam. The results of the ICC exam must be submitted with the application. Toledo Municipal Code - Section 1111.1101 "CERTIFICATES OF APPROPRIATENESS"

The following is the text of the Toledo Municipal Code "Certificates of Appropriateness."

1111.1101 Applicability: No contractor, owner or other person may make any environmental changes to any property designated as a historical landmark or within a designated historic district unless a valid written Certificate of Appropriateness has been issued by the respective Historic District Commission in accordance with procedures of this Section.

1111.1103 Initiation: Applications for a Certificate of Appropriateness for environmental changes upon landmarks or within designated historic districts shall be submitted directly to the Planning Director on forms provided by the Plan Commission, together with four complete sets of all applicable plans, designs, elevations, specifications and documents relating thereto.

1111.1104 No Retroactive Certificates: Applications for retroactive Certificates of Appropriateness shall not be accepted, and retroactive Certificates of Appropriateness shall not be issued.

1111.1105 Planning Director's Review and Report: Upon receipt of all pertinent documents, the Planning Director:

- **A.** must inform the applicant of the review procedures and application requirements;
- **B.** has the authority to request from the applicant additional pertinent information regarding the proposed environmental change;
- **C.** must inform the respective Historic District Commission members of the Certificate of Appropriateness applications.

The undersigned applicant for a contractor license or registration with the City of Toledo, acknowledges his/her knowledge of Chapter 1111.1101 which requires the prior approval of the Historic District Commission having jurisdiction for any environmental changes to property within the historic district. Without limiting the generality of the forgoing, the undersigned hereby agrees to comply with the provisions of 1111.1101 of the Toledo Municipal Code.
