How Water Rates Affect Your Bill

The chart below is based on **4 CCF** water usage (average for a 4 person household).

All customers who fall below the eligible household income can apply for WRAP to receive a **25% discount on their water volume rate**.

Renters are eligible when their unit has an individual meter - even if the landlord pays the water bill. Complete a landlord-tenant agent authority agreement to be eligible.

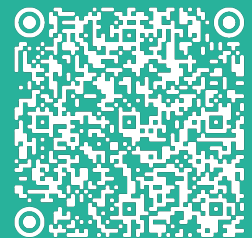
Improve or expand your home. Save money on taxes.

Residential tax abatement (RTA) offers a **100% abatement** on increased property value associated with an improvement project.

➔ toledo.oh.gov/RTA



Single-family homes and multi-family structures with four or fewer units qualify for the RTA program. The abatement period extends up to 12 years for significant renovations and up to 15 years for new construction. Scan the code to get started.



Qualifications

- ✓ Property is located in the City of Toledo
- ✓ Applicant is the property owner
- ✓ Property taxes and assessments are current
- ✓ Property complies with all zoning, permit, and license requirements
- ✓ Application is submitted prior to the start of construction

Employee Spotlight: Dana Reising

In Toledo's pursuit of a greener future, Dana Reising stands at the forefront, leading the charge.

Dana Reising began working with the City in 2019 as a city planner in developmental services. When the opportunity to become the Sustainability Manager arose, she seized it. Her educational background aligned perfectly – she studied geography at Bowling Green State University for her undergrad and earned her master's in applied climatology at Michigan State. During her master's program, she researched wind and crafted a climatological atlas of wind in the US, publishing several articles with the support of her advisors.

For Dana, sustainability boils down to the elemental principles of “reduce, reuse, recycle.” The initiatives she spearheads for the City focus on assessing operations and what the City can do to be less impactful on the environment and reduce greenhouse gases.

With Toledo as her home and her role as the Sustainability Manager with the City, Reising believes it is more important than ever to contribute substantially to Toledo's commitment to sustainability. “A healthy environment has proven benefits, providing people with essentials like clean water, fresh air, and access to parks. The ability to walk to school and enjoy the beauty of nature, I believe, are fundamental rights.”

Structure Concern

We respond to reports of structure concerns on privately-owned property including graffiti, broken down vehicles, or property maintenance concerns.

Blight Concern

We respond to reports of blight concerns, including debris, trash, or illegal dumping on public or abandoned properties.

Hydrant Concern

We respond to reports of hydrant concerns including frozen hydrants, leaking hydrants, or hydrants in need of maintenance or repair.

Water Backup Inside

We respond to reports of flooding or sewer odors in your basement caused by broken or obstructed sewer lines or unusually heavy rainfall.
