- 1. A minimum of thirty (30) days and a maximum of sixty (60) days shall be allowed before the preliminary drawing is presented to the Plan Commission for action.
- 2. Fifteen (15) blackline prints of the preliminary drawings shall be submitted to the Plan Commission.
- 3. One reduced velox or PMT of the original tracing shall be submitted. The format of the reduction may vary from 8-1/2" x 11" to 11" by 17", depending upon the configuration of the plat.
- 4. The preliminary drawing shall meet all requirements of the approved Subdivision Rules and Regulations.

The Subdivision Rules and Regulations applicable:

- a. Within the City of Toledo City of Toledo Subdivision Rules and Regulations.
- b. Outside the corporate limits of Toledo Lucas County Subdivision Rules and Regulations.

Final Plats

- 1. Once all clearances have been received, a maximum of thirty (30) days shall be allowed before the final plat is presented to the Plan Commission.
- One mylar original shall be submitted to the Plan Commission.
- 3. Fifteen (15) copies of the final plat shall be submitted to the Plan Commission.
- 4. A carbon copy of the receipt for the final plat shall be given to the individual delivering the final plat to the Plan Commission.
- 5. The final plat shall meet all requirements of the approved Subdivision Rules and Regulations.
