

Whitmer Dr. Reconstruction Tremainsville to Alexis

The City of Toledo is working with Washington Local Schools to relocate Whitmer Dr. and the campus parking lot. The goal of this project is to improve safety and increase multi-modal mobility on the Whitmer High School campus.



Project Outcomes

- Roundabout to slow traffic on Whitmer Dr.
- Pedestrian infrastructure improves safety for students to bike, walk, or roll.
- Improves current road condition.
- Updated water and sewer infrastructure.

Project Details

- **Waterline** relocation began in late February and is nearly complete.
- **Sanitary sewer** relocation began week of April 28.
- **Storm Sewer** improvements from Lyceum to Sullivan in May and June.
- **Parking lot & road reconstruction** June - October.
- Intersection shifts on new Whitmer Dr. at Herst and Tremainsville.
- **Raised crosswalk** for pedestrian safety crossing Edgar St.
- **Multi-use path** between road and parking lot.

Construction Cost Estimate: \$7 million

- Waterline: \$760k
- Reconstruction: \$6.27M
